PBR TEAMS: RIDGEDALE – PBR (Professional Bull Riders) heads into its sixth event of the 2026 PBR Teams league season in Ridgedale, Mo. The Missouri Thunder (9-5) enter with a six-game win streak and sit No. 2 in the standings, hoping to overtake the No. 1 Nashville Stampede (10-4). Bass Pro Shops PBR Thunder Days presented by DoorDash begins Friday, Sept. 4 at 7:45 p.m. CT, followed by day two of the event on Saturday, Sept. 5 at 6:45 p.m. CT and day three on Sunday, Sept. 6 at 2:15 p.m. CT.

CLOSING IN AT THE TOP – After once leading the standings by three games, the No. 1 Nashville Stampede have lost three of their last five games and their lead atop the standings has diminished over the past two weekends to a single game as the Missouri Thunder and Carolina Cowboys close in. The No. 2 Thunder swept in Nashville and Austin to enter their homestand with a six-game win streak, riding on home turf in attempting to overtake the Stampede. The New York Mavericks also snapped a six-game losing streak in Austin to get on the path toward making up ground with seven regular-season events to go. As 21 games remain through seven regular-season events ahead of the Teams Championship in Las Vegas, the battle ensues as the teams aim to separate themselves in the coming weeks.

PARITY AT THE TOP – Each of the eight original teams has now played 133 regular season games through four and a half years with the three teams at the top of the all-time standings having identical records. Austin, Texas and Florida have all won 78 games and lost 55, for a .587 winning percentage. Even more remarkable is that all three teams are within 500 total points of each other through all those games, with Austin first, Texas second and Florida third.

Head Coach Jerome Davis:

One of the PBR co-founders, Jerome Davis was the 1995 PRCA World Bull Riding Champion, becoming the first man east of the Mississippi to win a bull riding world championship. He competed with the PRCA and PBR until 1998, when he was tragically paralyzed from the chest down after being thrown from a bull and breaking his neck. Despite his injury, the PBR Ring of Honor inductee has continued to stay active, including partnering with his wife Tiffany to serve as a longtime stock contractor for the PBR and operating rodeo and bull riding events at the Davis Family Ranch in Archdale, North Carolina. Tiffany is the Director of Team Relations of the Carolina Cowboys. Jerome was named the PBR Teams Coach of the Year in 2025 after leading the Cowboys to the 2025 PBR Teams Championship.

Assistant Coach Robson Palermo:

During the 2023 PBR Teams season, Robson Palermo joined the Carolina Cowboys as the Assistant Coach. Inducted into the prestigious Ring of Honor in 2021, Palermo is one of PBR's most accomplished riders and is the only three-time PBR World Finals event winner and the only back-to-back winner (2011-2012). Palermo went a torrid 32-for-57 (56.14%) in 10 World Finals appearances and won 13 premier series events in his career, recording 37 90-point rides on the premier series before retiring in 2018.

Head Coach J.W. Hart:

J.W. Hart, known as “the Ironman,” is a former rider and PBR Ring of Honor inductee. He won the World Finals Event in 2002 and was the Rookie of the Year in 1995. Hart was given his nickname after competing in a record 197 consecutive PBR events (a record since broken by Missouri Thunder General Manager Luke Snyder) from 1994-2003. Hart earned more than \$1.3 million during his career and worked on the PBR broadcast team before joining the Kansas City Outlaws. Hart also boasted previous coaching experience, having worked alongside Nashville’s Head Coach Justin McBride during several iterations of the PBR Global Cup USA, leading the Team USA Eagles. With his wife LeAnn, he owns Hart Cattle Company, breeding and training bulls to compete in the PBR.

Assistant Coach Guilherme Marchi:

Guilherme Marchi transitioned into his new role with the Kansas City Outlaws with his name firmly etched into the PBR record books, inducted into the prestigious Ring of Honor in 2019. No rider in PBR history has stayed on more bulls than Marchi – the all-time ride leader with 635 qualified elite series rides. A beloved figure among fans around the world, the determined rider with the warm smile retired from U.S. competition after the 2018 PBR World Finals, where he had competed 15 consecutive times from 2004-2018. During his 15-year career, Marchi won 25 premier series events, including the PBR World Finals in 2005. He came heartbreakingly close to becoming a multi-time World Champion, finishing runner-up in the world standings four times (2005-2007, 2012). His accomplishments and approachability have helped PBR move into the mainstream. In 2016, Men’s Fitness named him “the fittest athlete in sports,” putting him on the magazine’s cover. No stranger to the role of coach, Marchi led Team Brazil at the 2020 Global Cup USA.

General Manager Luke Snyder:

Luke Snyder, PBR Ring of Honor and 2014 Missouri Sports Hall of Fame inductee, watched the film 8 Seconds as a 10-year-old and knew he'd be a bull rider. Snyder emulated Lane Frost on and off the dirt. In PBR competition, he lays claim to perhaps the most impressive record in any professional sport – competing in 275 consecutive events. During nine years of not missing an elite-level event, Snyder battled through a torn rotator cuff, broken right hand, groin pull, broken fibula and broken neck (the latter coinciding with a break in the schedule, allowing him sufficient time to recover). In addition to winning the PBR World Finals in 2001, the year he also won Rookie of the Year, Snyder won six premier series events, including the 2011 Last Cowboy Standing. He qualified for the World Finals 13 times and is No. 31 on PBR's all-time list of earners.

Head Coach Ross Coleman:

Ross Coleman rode his first calf when he was 7, won the College National Finals Rodeo all-around title in 1998, and made the PBR Finals in 1999, the first year he went pro, as well as every year thereafter until he retired, ending his 13-year professional career. A native of Molalla, Oregon, Coleman is a member of PBR's exclusive "400 Club" with 438 qualified rides, including 45 for 90 points or more. He won eight PBR premier series events and earned \$1.4 million during his career. In 2012, he was inducted into the PBR Ring of Honor, the most prestigious honor for any bull rider. Coleman has coaching experience in the PBR Global Cup, leading Team USA Eagles to victory at the five-nation tournament in March 2022. He has also run a bull riding school in his home state of Oregon.

Head Coach Kody Lostroh:

Kody Lostroh was named the Head Coach of the New York Mavericks after serving as an Assistant Coach for the Oklahoma Freedom during the league's first seasons. Ten-time PBR World Finals Qualifier Lostroh reached the pinnacle of the sport in 2009 when he was crowned World Champion following a feverish battle with J.B. Mauney. After stepping away from the PBR following the 2014 season, Lostroh was diagnosed with a tumor around his carotid artery in 2015. While Lostroh made a full recovery and briefly returned to competition, he officially retired in March 2018 and has since resided in Colorado with his wife and children. In 2023, Lostroh received the most prestigious honor a bull rider can receive, inducted into the PBR Ring of Honor.
