BACK-TO-BACK GARDENS – After making its debut with two sold out nights inside an electric TD Garden in Boston, Massachusetts, the PBR Unleash The Beast season continues in New York City at Madison Square Garden, marking its 19th stop at the historic building. “The World’s Most Famous Arena” will host the rankest bulls and toughest cowboys from around the world for three nights, starting at 8 p.m. ET on Friday and Saturday with a 2 p.m. ET start on Sunday with all the action being available on Paramount+ along with a special one hour broadcast of the Monster Energy Team Challenge on Saturday at 3:30 p.m. ET on CBS

STORIES AHEAD OF THE CUT – After New York, the tour will cut the five lowest ranked cowboys on the tour and bring up the top five in the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour, making this an important weekend for numerous riders on the bottom cutline while the top continues to shift.

Marco Rizzo – Rizzo overtook the top spot in the UTB standings after Dalton Kasel held it for the first two events with Rizzo taking home his first premier tour victory in Chicago and finishing runner-up in Boston. Rizzo, a 20-year-old cowboy is aiming to maintain the coveted top placing in just his second appearance at the Garden.

Brady Fielder – Fielder has remained consistent along the first three events, finishing ninth in Manchester, sixth in Chicago, and winning in Boston – his fourth career victory. After finishing runner-up in the MVP Race in the separate PBR Teams league, Fielder is determined this season to grab gold not silver.

Daniel Keeping – Sitting in the hot spot of the tour as the first potential ride to be cut, Keeping aims to change the trajectory of his season, after claiming his first ride of the season in Boston with 86.80-points on Shazam. The 26-year-old is one of three Texas Rattlers currently on the premier tour.

Jess Lockwood – The two-time World Champion makes his season debut at the Garden with an interesting twist. Lockwood won the event in 2017 and 2019 then went on each year to win the World Championship. He has his eyes on hoisting the Charging Bull trophy on Sunday afternoon, on a run to becoming the fourth three-time World Champion when World Finals concludes in May.

MONSTER ENERGY TEAM CHALLENGE RETURNS - The Monster Energy Team Challenge will be contested throughout the PBR Unleash The Beast (UTB) season, bringing a new layer of competition and added intensity to select UTB events. During 10 Unleash The Beast events, teams will compete in two head-to-head games per event, featuring 4-on-4 matchups for a total of 16 outs per event. Madison Square Garden will host a blockbuster doubleheader to start the tournament when a heated rivalry hits Broadway as the Austin Gamblers tangle with the Texas Rattlers. In the nightcap, the 2025 PBR Teams Champion Carolina Cowboys battle the New York Mavericks.

The teams, which will compete in the fifth season of the PBR Teams league from July - November, will accumulate wins and losses throughout the 10 Monster Energy Team Challenge events with the top four teams advancing to the METC Championship Tournament. The final four format in all three locations will feature one 7 x 7 head-to-head matchup per game (14 total outs).

The championship tournament will span three Unleash The Beast events during the stretch run of individual competition – Albuquerque (March 27), Billings (April 17), and the UTB regular season finale in Tacoma on April 24 – when the

remaining teams will battle in head-to-head 7 x 7 games in an elimination format to determine the inaugural Monster Energy Team Challenge champion.

DENVER, THE OUTLIER – Denver is the lone Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour event that will count for Unleash The Beast standings points this season. Several of the PBR’s best riders among the top tours will be competing at the event which is part of the National Western Stock Show held at Denver Coliseum starting Monday, January 12 through Wednesday, January 14 for a chance to showcase their talents and earn valuable points.

MORE PRECISE JUDGING AND SCORING – PBR has introduced a refined judging system for the 2026 season, shifting to tenth-point (.1) scoring for both riders and bulls to preserve the traditional structure while allowing judges to capture subtle performance differences that were previously obscured under the half-point model. A two-year study of more than 15,500 top-level rides showed that elite bulls deliver remarkably similar performances – 96% of bull scores over 19 fell between 20.0 and 22.0, and 81% cluster tightly between 20.5 and 21.5 –effectively limiting judges to just a few scoring “buckets.” The new increments let judges distinguish more precisely, such as scoring a bull 21.2 instead of being forced into 21.0 or 21.5, with the same nuance applied to rider dominance, control, and spurring. While ties may still occur, they should be far less common, and a built-in variance cap ensures a rider’s score cannot exceed the bull’s by more than 3.0 points, maintaining balance between components. Because judges already evaluate in tenths informally, making .1 increments official aligns scoring with real practice, delivering greater accuracy, transparency, and fairness for fans, riders, and coaches as PBR enters 2026.

2026 PBR POINTS SYSTEMS – The 2026 PBR Unleash The Beast (UTB) season enters its fourth week of action in New York, New York, keeping the same elite tour point structure as 2025 but re-adding PBR Majors. The 2026 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most Unleash The Beast points. Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR’s international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2026 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour’s first four events.

Those with the most points in the Velocity Global standings will join the UTB, replacing riders who fall to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. The first rider cut takes place after the fourth UTB event in New York City, New York, on Jan. 9-11. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the leaders in the Velocity Global standings. Following the first cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport’s top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into Milwaukee, Wisconsin, on Jan. 16-17. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR’s elite tour. Following the initial cut, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB. If a rider is offered an invite to the UTB but declines, he will forgo any future UTB invites off the Velocity Global standings for the remainder of the season but is eligible to compete in the World Finals if he qualifies through the Velocity Tour.

Points will be awarded as follows for Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as PBR Majors:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.95 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.95 8 bonus points and 90-99.95 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

LET'S TALK QUALIFIERS – As the new Unleash The Beast (UTB) season hits its stride, below is the qualification system for New York City. The field for the first four events is determined via a combination of factors, including a rider's performance in the PBR Teams League, which concluded its fourth season in late October.

Here are the criteria the PBR will use to determine the riders who will compete at the first four Unleash The Beast events in Manchester, Chicago, Boston, and New York City:

- All PBR World Champions who competed in at least one 2025 UTB event and/or qualified for the 2025 PBR World Finals.
- The Top 15 riders from the 2025 PBR Teams League MVP standings who are not already qualified through PBR World Champion status. The Top 15 was determined by the cumulative ride scores of individual riders across all outs at PBR Teams events, including the Play-In Game and PBR Teams Championship events during the season.
- The Top 5 riders from the 2025 PBR Challenger Series standings who are not already qualified through the above criteria will earn qualification. For clarity, if one of the Top 5 riders in the Challenger Series standings is already qualified, the rider ranked No. 6 will then get the position, and so on.
- The two highest-ranking riders who finished in the Top 40 in the 2025 PBR world standings who also competed in the previous year's PBR World Finals and are not already qualified through any of the above scenarios.
- Ten riders selected by their respective teams from the year-end active rosters.
- Any remaining positions will be filled with a maximum of 10 additional riders based on the PBR Teams cumulative ride score standings, who must have finished in the Top 40 in the previous year's PBR world standings and/or competed in the previous year's PBR World Finals.

Following the first four events, the Unleash The Beast field will be set via the tour's standings and subject to the rolling cuts as identified above.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of the 2026 PBR Monster Energy Buck Off at the Garden presented by Ariat in New York City will feature 10 rematches.

- Afonso Quintino and Hoobastank meet for the second time this season after combining for 82.15 points in Manchester which resulted in a re-ride opportunity.
- Andrew Alvidrez and Nobody met in Indianapolis in February 2025, combining for a monster score of 92.50 looking to make magic happen again.
- Claudio Montanha Jr. seeks his first ride on Feel The Magic after being bucked off in 2.99 seconds during Thunder Days.
- Daniel Keeping and Rockville will aim for their first official ride Friday night with the last attempt resulting in a re-ride opportunity.
- John Crimber is seeking revenge after being bucked off Holy Roller in Manchester in 2.38 seconds.
- Julio Cesar Marques and Tulsa time last met in December 2024 in Albany with the duo earning a score of 88.75 points.
- Kaiden Loud and Snuggles hold an even 1-1 record with the last outing between the two resulting in a 2.51-second buckoff.
- Luciano De Castro aims to earn his first ride on OptiWize Mercy with the two not meeting since August 2024.
- Sage Steele Kimzey last rode Blue Duck in September 2025 in Belmont, Park New York for 88.50 points and aims to remain perfect against the bovine.
- Thiago Salgado also seeks perfected in a rematch against Ridin' Salty, the duo tangoing in Nashville, Tennessee for 89.5 points during Stampede Days.

PAST NEW YORK CITY EVENT WINNERS – PBR is stopping at Madison Square Garden for the 19th time in its 33-season history. Lucas Divino won the tentpole event in 2025 with a total of 262.25 points to win by a notable 12.50 points. Bouncing back from a buck off in round 1, Divino connected with Fierce's Dirtnap for 86.25 points in the second round. In Round 3 on Sunday, he rode Boot Barn's Pack Rat for 87.25 points to clinch a spot in the Championship Round. Once there, Divino bested Punch Pete for 88.75 points, the second-highest score of the round to win the event buckle.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL UPDATE – The 2026 YETI PBR World Champion Bull will be determined by both the 2025 PBR Teams league season and the 2026 Unleash The Beast season. The 2026 World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Teams season and UTB regular seasons and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of a PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or

more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular season out, the score at World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs, and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bucking Bull Award.

THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT – PBR Monster Energy Buck Off at the Garden presented by Ariat in New York City, the fourth Unleash The Beast event of the 2026 season and final before the cut, will feature four rounds of bull riding. Each of the 43 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday, Round 2 on Saturday, and Round 3 on Sunday*. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1-3 will then advance to the championship round following Round 3 on Sunday.

* Qynn Anderson must ride Friday night to continue at the event.

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast heads east to Milwaukee, Wisconsin for Busch Light PBR Milwaukee presented by Cooper Tires. The event begins Friday and Saturday at 7 p.m. ET both nights.

PROVIDING PROTECTION – This weekend's bull fighters are Lucas Teodoro of Pinhal, Brazil; Austin Ashley of Wynnewood, Oklahoma; and Cody Webster of Wayne, Oklahoma.

TELEVISION BROADCAST – All four rounds of action in New York City will be shown on Paramount+ in a new five-year deal signed with the streaming platform. Friday and Saturday's action will be streamed in its entirety on Paramount+ starting at 8 p.m. ET both nights with Sunday's rides starting at 2 p.m. ET. The Monster Energy Teams Challenge will air on Saturday on CBS from 3:30-4:30 p.m. ET.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier, will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events – \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events – \$10,000 - \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events – \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.95 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.95 8 bonus points and 90-99.95 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.
