SECOND TIME AROUND– Following two sold-out nights for its 2025 debut in Pittsburgh, the PBR Unleash The Beast enters The Steel City for just the second time in its 33-year history at PPG Paints Arena Feb. 13-14. This weekend's U.S. Border Patrol PBR Pittsburgh presented by Ariat – the ninth event of the 2026 premier series campaign – begins on Friday night at 8 p.m. ET with the first round before concluding on Saturday night at 8 p.m. ET with the second slate and championship round. This weekend's action is available to viewers on Paramount+ with the Monster Energy Team Challenge (Florida vs. Nashville and Austin vs. Arizona) carried on the CBS Television Network on Feb. 15 at 12 p.m. ET

FRESH OFF THE CUT – The riders buck into Pittsburgh fresh off the season's third cut, each happening following New York (Jan. 9-11), Tampa (Jan. 23-24), and last weekend's Salt Lake City (Feb. 6-7). Riders who sat below the No. 35 rank, excluding cowboys with remaining exemptions, found themselves relegated to Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour (PWVT) competition, thus paving the way for said tour's top-performing riders receiving a shot to make some noise on the sport's grandest stage. Felipe Furlan is on his last guaranteed event while Austin Richardson returns for his second guaranteed event of the season.

Invites for this weekend include Ciac Cassio Varcvalho who won in Grand Forks, North Dakota and Elijah Jennings after winning in Hampton, Virginia and moving into the Top 5 in the Global Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Standings. Also receiving invites for being in the Top 5 are Ezekiel Mitchell, Wyatt Rogers, Kase Hitt, and Grayson Cole.

This year's title race is tight, and the top cowboys are showing their exceptional grit and skills:

- The top 3 – John Crimber, Dalton Kasel and Clay Guiton – are separated by a mere 34.5 points
- The Top 11 are within 250 points
- The Top 10 are bringing it every week - all riding at 50% or better

NOTABLE RIDERS TO KEEP AN EYE ON

Paulo Eduardo Rossetto – After earning his first win of the season in Salt Lake City, Paulo Eduardo Rossetto currently sits in fourth in the UTB Standings after eight events in the books. Rossetto has four Top 5 and five Top 10 finishes. He resides 103 points behind the standings leader John Crimber and remains just one weekend away from being able to claim the top spot. He remains red-hot after starting out strong with three rides in Manchester, and two rides in Chicago, Boston, Tampa, and Salt Lake City.

John Crimber – Crimber topped the UTB Standings for the first time this season following a second-place performance in Salt Lake City, coming up just 2.65 points short of his second straight win in Utah. Even having bucked off in the Championship Round in Salt Lake City, the young 20-year-old has ridden seven of his last eight bulls going back to the second round in Tampa. His time in Tampa was followed up by a perfect 4-for-4 weekend in Sacramento and two straight rides in Salt Lake City. The west has proven fruitful for Crimber in the rankings and as he travels back across the country, fans wait to see what's in store.

Dalton Kasel – Kasel will return to action in Pittsburgh after missing Salt Lake City due to an injury and falling from the top spot in the rankings by 22 points. The 2025 World Champion runner-up has had a chip on his shoulder since surrendering the 2025 gold buckle on the final day and remains the only rider to win multiple events this season, coming out on top in Manchester and Milwaukee.

Sage Steele Kimzey – Kimzey’s strong suit in 2026 has been steady performances, riding at least one bull in six of his seven events with Milwaukee being the outlier while finishing in the Top 10 in three of his last four outings. He had three straight events with finishes of 24th, 14th, and 15th before turning a corner in New York City with the victory, later finishing third in Tampa and seventh in Sacramento, earning 284 of his 319 points across the trifecta.

Julio Cesar Marques – After starting out the season smooth as an X-Factor making appearances in the Championship Round in the first four events, Marques has hit a rough patch after not riding in Tampa and finishing 20th and 15th in Sacramento and Salt Lake City, respectively. He aims to get back on track after riding Bayou Boy for 86.05 points Friday night of Salt Lake City but then bucking off.

Jose Vitor Leme – Following a slow start to the season, three-time World Champion Jose Vitor Leme turned in his third-straight Top 15 showing in Sacramento courtesy of an eighth-place tie with Daniel Keeping via his 2-for-3 slate. He missed the ensuing week in Salt Lake City but is back in action this weekend. He’s also shy of reaching an important career milestone as he tried to move into third all-time in the rankings of career Championship Round 90-point rides. He’s currently tied with Chris Shivers and Guilherme Marchi with 34. Justin McBride sits in second with 37 and J.B. Mauney leads the pack with 38.

MONSTER ENERGY TEAM CHALLENGE HITS MIDSEASON FORM – The Monster Energy Team Challenge is being contested throughout the PBR Unleash The Beast (UTB) season, bringing a new layer of competition and added intensity to select UTB events. During 10 Unleash The Beast events, teams compete in two head-to-head games per event, featuring 4-on-4 matchups for a total of 16 outs per event.

In Pittsburgh on Friday night, the METC action begins with the reigning regular-season champion Florida Freedom (0-1) taking on the undefeated Nashville Stampede (1-0) as the two head into their second game of the season. Immediately after, The Austin Gamblers (2-0) and Arizona Ridge riders (0-2) challenge one another as Austin aims to be the second 3-0 team this season, joining the Missouri Thunder.

The teams, which will compete in the fifth season of the PBR Teams league from July - November, will accumulate wins and losses throughout the 10 Monster Energy Team Challenge events with the top four teams advancing to the METC Championship Tournament. The final four format in all three locations will feature one 7 x 7 head-to-head matchup per game (14 total outs).

The championship tournament will span three Unleash The Beast events during the stretch run of individual competition – Albuquerque (March 27), Billings (April 17), and the UTB regular season finale in Tacoma on April 24 – when the remaining teams will battle in head-to-head 7 x 7 games in an elimination format to determine the inaugural Monster Energy Team Challenge champion.

MORE PRECISE JUDGING AND SCORING – PBR has introduced a refined judging system for the 2026 season, shifting to tenth-point (.1) scoring for both riders and bulls to preserve the traditional structure while allowing judges to capture subtle performance differences that were previously obscured under the half-point model. A two-year study of more than 15,500 top-level rides showed that elite bulls deliver remarkably similar performances – 96% of bull scores over 19 fell between 20.0 and 22.0, and 81% cluster tightly between 20.5 and 21.5 –effectively limiting judges to just a few scoring “buckets.” The new increments let judges distinguish more precisely, such as scoring a bull 21.2 instead of being forced into 21.0 or 21.5, with the same nuance applied to rider dominance, control, and spurring. While ties may still occur, they should be far less common, and a built-in variance cap ensures a rider’s score cannot exceed the bull’s by more than 3.0 points, maintaining balance between components. Because judges already evaluate in tenths informally, making .1 increments official aligns scoring with real practice, delivering greater accuracy, transparency, and fairness for fans, riders, and coaches as PBR enters 2026.

2026 PBR POINTS SYSTEMS – The 2026 PBR Unleash The Beast (UTB) season enters its ninth week of action in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania keeping the same elite tour point structure as 2025 but re-adding PBR Majors. The 2026 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most Unleash The Beast points. Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR’s international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which

will also be used to crown the 2026 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events.

Those with the most points in the Velocity Global standings will join the UTB, replacing riders who fall to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. The first rider cut takes place after the fourth UTB event in New York City, New York, on Jan. 9-11. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the leaders in the Velocity Global standings. Following the first cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into Milwaukee, Wisconsin, on Jan. 16-17. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB. If a rider is offered an invite to the UTB but declines, he will forgo any future UTB invites off the Velocity Global standings for the remainder of the season but is eligible to compete in the World Finals if he qualifies through the Velocity Tour.

Points will be awarded as follows for Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as PBR Majors:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.95 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.95 8 bonus points and 90-99.95 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

FAMILIAR TERRITORY – Round 1 of the U.S. Border Patrol PBR Pittsburgh presented by Ariat will feature eight rematches.

- Sage Steele Kimzey has remained a perfect 4-for-4 aboard Mike's Motive dating back to 2023 with the last ride resulting in 43.25 points in last season's World finals.
- Afonso Quintino seeks his first qualified ride against Mr. Jimmy after being bucked off in Tampa three weeks ago in 7.50 seconds.
- Andrew Alvidrez bested Dark Thoughts in May 2024 during the PBR World Finals Eliminations for 89.25 points as the duo meets again.

- Cassio Dias and Hoobastank met during PBR Teams: Duluth with the ride resulting in a re-ride attempt with this weekend marking the first official meeting.
- Ezekiel Mitchell and Muddy Jake meet for the first time on the premier series after the duo tangoed in Lexington in January 2024 for 5.96 seconds.
- John Crimber and Mystfied will meet for the first official time this weekend after the first attempt in March 2025 in Albuquerque resulted in a re-ride.
- Julio Cesar Marques bested Project X for 85.25 points in the season-opener in Manchester with his eyes set on remaining perfect aboard the bovine.
- Paulo Eduardo Rossetto bucked off Chico in January 2025 during a Last Cowboy Standing event in Fort Worth in 2.47 seconds with the recent event winner seeking revenge.

PAST PITTSBURGH EVENT WINNERS – PBR’s premier series returns to Pittsburgh for just the second time this weekend, with Brady Fielder earning the event win in 2025 at the sport’s debut at PPG Points Arena. Fielder was one of two riders to stay on all three bulls attempted, winning the event by a sheer half-point 262.25-261.75 over Felipe Furlan. Fielder rode Money Moves for 86.50 points in the opening round and earned another 85.00 points in the next round to qualify for the Championship Round. Once there, the Australian cowboy bested UTZ BesTex Smokestack as the duo combined for 90.75 points to put on a thrilling show in PBR’s debut in the Steel City.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL UPDATE – The 2026 YETI PBR World Champion Bull will be determined by both the 2025 PBR Teams league season and the 2026 Unleash The Beast season. The 2026 World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Teams season and UTB regular seasons and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of a PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the stock contractors who own said bulls.

For avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular season out, the score at World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs, and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bucking Bull Award.

THIS WEEKEND’S FORMAT – U.S. Border Patrol PBR Pittsburgh presented by Ariat, the ninth Unleash The Beast event of the 2026 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 43 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday* and one bull in Round 2 on Saturday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1-2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Saturday.

- Cleber Henrique Marques must ride Friday night to stay in the competition.

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast heads south to Jacksonville, Florida for Progressive PBR Jacksonville Friday, Feb. 20 and Saturday, Feb. 21. Both days of action are scheduled to begin at 8 p.m. ET.

PROVIDING PROTECTION – This weekend’s bull fighters are Lucas Teodoro of Pinhal, Brazil; Austin Ashley of Wynnewood, Oklahoma; and Nathan Harp of Tuttle, Oklahoma.

TELEVISION BROADCAST – All three rounds of action in Pittsburgh will be shown on Paramount+ in a new five-year deal signed with the streaming platform. This weekend’s action will be streamed on Paramount+ starting at 8 p.m. ET on Friday and Saturday. The two Monster Energy Team Challenge games will air on CBS Television Network on Sunday, Feb. 15 at 12 a.m. ET.

The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added

- Tier 1 Events – \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events – \$10,000 - \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events – \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.95 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.95 8 bonus points and 90-99.95 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.
